

A35 Quorum for West Lothian selection meetings

Motion text

- 1 In the Standing Orders, replace:
- 2 1.4.11. To be quorate, any General Meeting of the Branch must have at least 2%
- 3 of the membership, or five members, whichever is greater, present. Any normal
- 4 meeting (including a selection meeting) must have at least 1% of the membership
- 5 present.
- 6 With:
- 7 1.4.11. To be quorate, any General Meeting of the Branch must have at least 2%
- 8 of the membership, or five members, whichever is greater, present. Any normal
- 9 meeting (including a selection meeting) must have at least 1% of the membership
- 10 present.
- 11 1.4.12. For a selection meeting in West Lothian, open only to West Lothian
- 12 members, to be quorate, the selection meeting must have at least 1% of the
- 13 membership who live in West Lothian present.
- 14 Renumber accordingly.

Reason

It is fine in the national party constitution for these to be open to WL members only. However, in the branch SOs, it only refers to a quorum for selection meetings in terms of % of branch membership, so is ambiguous. This is aimed at addressing that.
