

A34 Removal of requirement to select candidates a year in advance

Proposer: Rob Gowans

Motion text

- 1 Delete 7.2 of the Constitution and renumber accordingly.
- 2 This removes this clause:
- 3 7.2 Candidates will be selected and announced for all constituencies and wards
- 4 at least one year in advance of any scheduled election. Except where a candidate
- 5 can no longer stand, in which case a new candidate will be selected as soon as
- 6 practicable. Other than in the case of a by-election, or where a candidate can
- 7 no longer stand, all candidates for a given election cycle will be selected at
- 8 the same time as part of a single process.

Reason

This time constraint of 1 year is unnecessarily restrictive.
